Service Innovation & Equity

- Care Plus Program: The early integration of palliative care model, Care Plus, has now been expanded to new metropolitan and regional sites, delivering earlier, evidence-based palliative care for advanced cancer—including the "Care Plus Brain" study for high-grade glioma, and "Care Plus Extend' for people with sarcoma, colorectal and lung cancer. Telehealth and outreach improved access for rural and underserved populations.
- First Nations Cancer Care: The WCMICS First Nations Cancer Coordinator role established at Royal Melbourne Hospital is now a model for culturally safe, patient- and family-focused care, developed with a First Nations advisory group. An implementation toolkit was launched in July and is available <u>click here</u>
- Voices for Palliative Care: With the input of a dedicated community group, Voices is developing advocacy work to strengthen the voice of lived experience in research, service development, training and in public discussion around palliative care
- Touchstone Project: Working with collaborative partners across St Vincent's Health Australia involving Melbourne, Sydney (Davinia Seah) and Brisbane (Phillip Good) palliative care units, Touchstone involves interrogation of existing datasets to understand and improve care for people at the end of life.
